

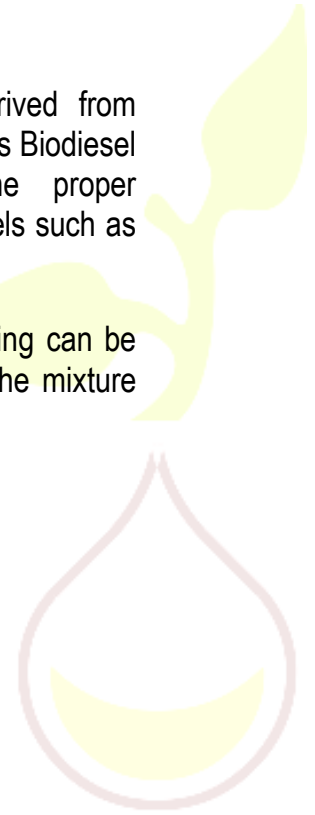

Biodiesel fuels are alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids derived from renewable resources. Detroit Diesel Corporation highly recommends Biodiesel fuels made from soybean or rapeseed oil through the proper transesterification process. Other feedstock source of Biodiesel fuels such as animal fat and used cooking oils are not recommended by DDC.

Biodiesel fuels meeting ASTM D6751 specification, prior to blending can be mixed up to 5% maximum by volume in petroleum diesel fuel. The mixture must meet the fuel properties listed by DDC and ASTM D6751.
