Volkswagen has determined that diesel fuel containing up to 5% Biodiesel meets the technical specifications for Volkswagen vehicles equipped with TDI engines imported to the US. Therefore, the diesel fuel commonly known as B5 Biodiesel is acceptable for use in all our TDI vehicles.

Volkswagen sees Biodiesel as a key element of a comprehensive long-range fuel strategy that relies on efficient, clean diesel technology and the use of an increasingly broad portfolio of renewable fuels.

Volkswagen continue to conduct research regarding the use of Biodiesel blend fuels, including higher blends such as B20 (20% Biodiesel, 80% petrodiesel), as well as to develop appropriate specifications that will assure the suitability of such fuels for use in our vehicles.

In summary:

1. Volkswagen recommends the use of standard diesel fuel or commercially supplied Biodiesel blends of no more than 5% Biodiesel.
2. Never use fuel, whether diesel, B%, or otherwise, that fails to meet the latest petroleum industry specifications.
3. Never use any fuel for which the contents cannot be identified.
