

# BIODIESEL TESTIMONIAL

## ALABAMA PORT AUTHORITY, USA

Alabama's state docks are increasing their use of Biodiesel fuels, the port authority announced.

The authority said all of its equipment will now operate on a blend of 20 percent Biodiesel and 80 percent petroleum diesel. All of the Biodiesel is made from soybeans.

The authority operates some 125 pieces of equipment to serve 1,100 acres of cargo terminals. Eight railway locomotive engines, three cranes and other gear are converting to the Biodiesel blend.

The pilot program was conducted during the first quarter.

U.S. Department of Agriculture tests concluded Biodiesel reduces carbon dioxide emissions by 16 percent. Carbon dioxide is a major contributor to global warming.

The authority directly handled more than 25 million tons of cargo and posted over \$89 million in revenues last year.
