The ODOT have purchased over 7,500,000 litres of B20 since switching to Biodiesel in 1999.

In terms of engine performance and maintenance, there has been no discernable difference between B20 and petroleum-diesel.

The heavy vehicle fleet is powered mainly by International, Caterpillar and Cummins engines, with several other diesel powered units within the fleet.

The public perception of alternative fuels and Biodiesel in particular has been favorable. The reasons are less dependence on foreign oil, good for the local economy and improvements in Greenhouse Gas emissions.
